Student flutes are for beginner players and are those used for marching band. These flutes are characterized by a C-foot joint (the lowest note), closed holes, and a plated body. Step-up violins are for an advancing student. They're often referred to as open-hole or French—this is anything above a student instrument.

How to Play the Flute:Playing the Flute - Musical

Download a flute fingering chart. * From the fifth bar onward, the fingering for E-C# (Db) is the same as for an octave. * The actual pitch of an alto flute is four tones down from the written score. * The actual pitch of a bass flute is eight tones (one octave) down from the written score. * The actual pitch of a piccolo is eight tones (one octave) up from the written score.
